Who Are They? Individuals employed by or under contract with the Eden Alternative for the purposes of training Certified EAH Trainers.

What Do They Do? Facilitate Eden at Home Trainer Certification Workshops & distribute certification to Certified Eden at Home Trainers.

How Do They Do It? They work under contract with the Eden Alternative to facilitate Eden at Home Trainer Certification Workshops.



Certified Eden at Home Trainers

Who Are They? Graduates of Eden at Home Trainer Certification Workshops. They can be staff and/or volunteers -- from non-profit organizations or state agencies focused on aging or long-term care, home-health organizations, faith-based organizations, Area Agencies on Aging, senior centers, adult day care services, hospices, hospitals or long-term care organizations with assisted living and/or independent living options, home health outreach, or an interest in supporting the ongoing needs of short-term rehabilitation patients who are headed back home.

What Do They Do? Facilitate Eden at Home Care Partner Workshops, sponsored by the organizations they represent, for care partners in their local community and/or in their organizations. They may also serve as change agents in their organizations.

How Do They Do It? They, along with the organizations they represent, schedule and promote Care Partner Workshops within their organizations and/or out in their local community. They can also help guide the infusion of EAH concepts and person-directed care into the internal daily operations of their organizations.



Participating Care Partners

Who Are They? The Elder herself, family members, friends, neighbors, volunteers, home health professionals, or anyone committed to changing the culture of care in their local community.

What Do They Do? They attend Eden at Home Care Partner Workshops facilitated by Eden at Home Certified Trainers, and then take their new tools and perspective home to inspire other members of their care partner teams.
