CURRENT ARTIFACTS FOR NURSING HOMES

42. Regularly scheduled intergenerational program in which children customarily interact with residents at least once a week.
43. Home makes space available for community groups to meet in home with residents welcome to attend.
44. Private guestroom available for visitors at no, or minimal, cost for overnight stays.
45. Home has café/restaurant/tavern/canteen available to residents, families, and visitors at which residents and family can purchase food and drinks daily.
46. Home has special dining room available for family use/gatherings which excludes regular dining areas.
47. Kitchenette or kitchen area with at least a refrigerator and stove is available to families, residents, and staff where cooking and baking are welcomed.

NEW for AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Facility

1. Regularly scheduled intergenerational program in which children customarily interact with residents at least once a week.
2. Facility has community room for outside groups to meet (depending on faculty's policy) and welcome residents to attend.
3. Depending on the facility accommodations, private guestroom available for visitors at no, or minimal, cost for overnight stays.
4. Facility has café/restaurant/tavern/canteen available to residents, families, and visitors at which residents and family can purchase food and drinks daily.
5. Have special dining room available for family use/gatherings which excludes regular dining areas.
6. Kitchenette or kitchen area with at least a refrigerator and stove is available to families, residents, and staff where cooking and baking are welcomed.

OTHER ISSUES FOR DISCUSSION

1. Some facilities are set up to accommodate some or all of the above but others are not. For example, there would be no room for overnight guests in a PRAC 202 but may be in an older Section 8 building.
2. Some facilities may have policies regarding outside groups using the community room. Tupperware or Avon parties may be an issue.
